WHAT IS THE RESTAURANT NEIGHBOR AWARD?

The National Restaurant Association's Restaurant Neighbor Award recognizes outstanding community service programs among our nation's restaurants. Each year, four national winners are chosen: a small business, a mid-size business, a large business/national chain, and one Cornerstone Humanitarian. Finalists are chosen by their state restaurant associations and then compete for one of four national awards. American Express is the founding partner of the award.

WHAT DO THE NATIONAL WINNERS RECEIVE?

- ✓ \$5,000 to support their community project or favorite charity.
- ✓ Expense-paid trip to Washington, D.C. for the gala awards dinner.
- ✓ Profile in a widely distributed booklet and web section that highlights restaurant community service projects.
- ✓ Widespread recognition through the National Restaurant Association's public relations and marketing initiatives.

HOW DOES A RESTAURANT APPLY?

1. Complete the application form or apply online at www.restaurant.org/community. Incomplete applications will not be eligible for the award.

2. Choose a category:

- Restaurant Neighbor Award** (recognizing a small business, mid-size business and large business/national chain for a specific community project or program).
- Cornerstone Humanitarian** (recognizing an individual for his or her personal dedication to community service).

Please note: Large corporations that run a nationwide program or partner nationally with one charity must apply on behalf of their corporate offices for the "Large Business/National Chain" award. Individual franchisees can apply on behalf of their restaurants if they run a separate project, or one restaurant location of a large business/national chain can apply in the mid-size restaurant category for a program specific to that individual restaurant.

3. Submit:

Supporting materials such as support letters, newspaper articles, photos or promotional materials about the project (no more than 10 items will be accepted). All materials become the property of the National Restaurant Association and will not be returned.

Mid-size business

Annual sales between \$5 million and \$100 million or one restaurant or franchise of a national chain running a program specific to that restaurant.

Large business/ National chain

A national program run in all units nationwide and with sales of more than \$100 million.
